There are five restaurants for children in Cusco, Peru, where 600 neglected children (aged 5 -12) get two meals a day, help with their homework, as well as medical and dental treatment. They can play, take part in sports, or read in secure surroundings, are being helped emotionally, get attention, love and the chance of being a child. New: a project in which young people (aged 12 – 18 as well as a few students) can also take part.

Within two hours we basically sold out every product. The idea of the shops came when we found out that the shop further down the street was being closed.
